**The manuscript must be submitted to the IJIREST Editor, electronically through [editor.ijirest@gmail.com](mailto:editor.ijirest@gmail.com).**

All the manuscripts are accepted for peer review process only after getting consent from the Authors that the manuscript is not previously published and is not under consideration for publication by another journal and those manuscripts will be subjected to RAPID publication without any delay in subsequent issue. The manuscripts should be

Submitted with Author consent letter (download) by email. Each manuscript will be assigned a Manuscript Number and the same is mailed to the corresponding author with in Two working Days. The check list for the Final Manuscript and the Manuscript Submission were given at the End of this Guidelines.

If excerpts from other copyrighted works are included in the manuscript, the author must obtain written permission from the copyright owners and credit the source(s) in the article.

The manuscript should be prepared in English using "MS Word" with 1cm margin on all sides (Top, Bottom, Left and Right side) of the A4 paper. The font size of Title should be of 14pt and the main script should be of 12pt. Italic fonts should be followed for the scientific names of all plant and microorganisms. Then manuscript should be typed double spaced and should have the following sections: Title page, Abstract, Key words, Text, Acknowledgement (if any), Conflict of Interest (if Any) and References.

### **Review of Manuscripts**

All the manuscripts will be peer-reviewed. The comments of reviewers' and the decision of editor's will be communicated to the authors. Upon receipt, the Authors can recommend the qualified reviewer (Download the **Suggest Reviewer form**) for their manuscript. The selection of reviewers will be at the discretion of the Editor.

### **Title Page**

The title of the manuscript, Authors name and their Affiliations (indicated with suitable superscript indications) should be given on a separate page. In this Title page, the title of the Manuscript should be typed in 14 pt title case, bold face. The names of the authors should be in 12 pt normal face, upper case followed by the address(Institutional affiliations) in lower case and normal face. The corresponding Author name should be indicated with an asterisk (\*) as super script and complete address with email id, fax(if any ), telephone number should be given at the bottom of the title page.

The Corresponding author is the whole responsible to ensure that all co authors are aware and approve the contents of the submitted manuscript.

### **Abstract**

Abstract of the manuscript should address the details of the study problems, methodology implemented, findings and conclusion as one paragraph and should not exceed 250 words. This should be typed as a single spaced on the new page (second page of the manuscript).

### **Keywords**

About 4-6 informative English key words that deals with the most important aspects of the manuscript. This should be typed at the end of the abstract under separate heading.

### **Text**

The text for Full Length research articles should contain the following sections:

1. Introduction,
2. Methodology,
3. Results, Discussion (or Results and Discussion) and
4. Conclusions.

The Introduction should briefly state the purpose of the research and the related similar research works. The Materials and Methods section must specify the details of the instruments used, and experimental details. Results and Discussions section should be concisely presented. Results and discussion may be separate or combined based on the authors requirement. The interpreted results should be explained clearly in discussions and should relate them to the existing knowledge in the field as clearly as possible.

The Conclusion section reflect the importance of the carried research, relevant findings and future work. This section should be brief and limited to 300 words.

**Tables, Graphs and Figures**

Tables, Graphs and figures should be given at the end of the manuscript under separate headings .

Each table should be titled, typed on separate sheets in consecutive order using Arabic numerals. Indicate SI units of measure in parentheses.

The Figures must be clear and sharp. Digital files are recommended for highest quality reproduction and should follow the following guidelines
